Richard Hauer, Ph.D. is a Professor of Urban Forestry at the University of



Wisconsin – Stevens Point teaching courses in urban forestry, nursery management, woody plants, dendrology, and introduction to forestry. He received his B.S. from the University of Wisconsin – Stevens Point, M.S. from the University of Illinois, and Ph.D. from the University of Minnesota.

Rich has conducted research in tree biology, urban forest management, emerald ash borer management, trees and construction, tree risk management, and ice storms. He recently was honored as the 2018 L.C. Chadwick Award for Arboricultural Research. He has written over 140 publications and presented over 370 talks throughout the world.

# Trees, Construction, and Site Development Urban Forestry Workshop

This year's workshop will be offered a little differently. The program usually includes a classroom lecture style session in the morning and hand-on field activities in the afternoon. This year we will be offering the morning portion of the workshop online to allow more attendees and offer an educational option for those who are not yet comfortable attending in-person events. The hands-on activities will build on the online session but you are not required to attend the online session in order to attend the in-person portion of the class.

## Online Presentation via Zoom—August 19, 9 am to 11 am

If you could just change one thing, what would it be to minimize the impact of trees in construction areas? Learn a variety of ways to protect soils and trees during construction. This session will introduce different approaches to consider during construction activities that commonly occur around trees and explore industry A300 Standards and Best Management Practices. The cost for the Zoom presentation is \$10 per person. Registration deadline is August 13.

## In-Person Field Demonstration—9 am to Noon

Join us at one of four locations for an in-person program with three hours of field-based learning. Learn concepts such as the X-Factor, the Tree Protection Zone, and Tree Risk for decision making. The same content will be presented at each location. The cost is \$20 per person with a limit of 50 participants per location. Registration deadline is August 20 or when filled.

- Learn about the X-Factor and resilient characteristics trees might or might not have. The tree species, age, and condition help to determine the tree protection zone (TPZ).
- Setting up temporary movement areas and what is needed to avoid soil compaction.
- Learn how to use air excavation to remediate poor soils and correct buried tree root systems.
- Learn about an approach to assess a tree from roots to foliage and parts in between. Thinking strategical on what trees make sense to retain and which ones might just be a future headache.
