Jewelry

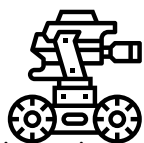

Youth will learn about possible quilting projects, get ideas, support or guidance on a quilting project they may already have chosen or learn how to start a project!

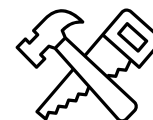
Youth do need a sewing machine, please bring it along. A few donated machines may be available for use at Project Night.
