Kids will make a suncatcher with beads and various natural materials to hang from a window to celebrate Earth Day on April 22<sup>nd</sup>. Session 1 & 2: all ages (limited to 20 youth)

## Goats



This session will help youth learn all about Goats. Participants do not need to have goats to come learn and engage in hands on fun! Session 1 & 2: all ages

## Jewelry



Youth will be taught how to make their own jewelry or can bring their own materials if they need assistance with a project. Youth in Advanced should bring projects they have started or will be able to begin a new one!

Session 1: 5th grade+, Advanced Jewelry  
Session 2: K-4<sup>th</sup> grade, Beginner

## Quilting

Youth can work on their quilting projects, get ideas, support or guidance to help finish a quilt. Bring your sewing machine & all quilting materials. Session 1 & 2: any age, parent support may be needed.



## Rocketry

Youth will learn how to assemble model rockets. All rocket building supplies and kits will be available and the cost of this project is \$5 per youth. The rocket project will meet at 2 additional project nights in preparation for a launch in Spring 2026. Session 2: age 9+ or 3<sup>rd</sup> grade+
